

## COVID-19 Homebound Vaccination Program

Northwell Health is determined to make COVID-19 vaccines more accessible as they continue to play an essential role in our progress against the virus. Homebound adults and children can greatly benefit from a vaccination because they are among the most at-risk populations for severe outcomes. Northwell Health Solutions is now making vaccinations available to these patients through its **Homebound Vaccination Program**. Vaccines continue to serve as the best solution to prevent serious illness and as a first line of defense against the virus.

Eligible patients for the Homebound Vaccination Program are those who cannot access vaccines at an administration site outside of the home due to clinical disease. This includes bedbound patients, those dependent on ambulette/ambulance for transportation or those who have behavioral limitations that make public spaces difficult.

A two-person highly trained Northwell clinical team will visit the patient in their home to support compassionate vaccination administration.
